Re : RoHS Compliance European Union Directive 2002/95/EC

Effective 1st July 1 2006 according to the RoHS Directive established by the European union, no product entering the market can contain more than the Maximum Concentration Value of Lead, Mercury, Cadmium, Hexavalent Chromium, Polybrominated Biphenyls or Polybrominated Diphenyl Ethers.

PKI Optoelectronics is in the process of converting its products to be RoHS-compliant. Some of our products are RoHS-compliant as of today and the commitment is to have all PKI Optoelectronics products to be RoHS-compliant by the July 2006 unless if exempted. PKI Optoelectronics is currently addressing this issue with our suppliers and subcontractors to assure full compactibility to the RoHS legislation as well as transforming our Bill-of-Materials to comply with the directive. We are also aggressively moving towards eliminating all harzardous material from our manufacturing processes to assure compliance with the RoHS standards.

Products in the Medical devices and Military equipment categories are currently exempted from restrictions on hazardous substances content. Article 4 (1) of the Directive provides that materials and components can be exempted from the substance restrictions if their elimination or substitution is technically or scientifically impracticable, or where the negative environmental, health or consumer safety impacts caused by substitution outweigh the benefits.

PKI Optoelectronics is committed to delivering the highest quality products to our customers that are in full compliance with the European Union's Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS) Directive. PKI Optoelectronics is also dedicated to supporting RoHS compliant products that benefit our customers and minimize impact to the environment.
